9:00 AM – Market Lake Ranch open to the public. Area biologists and naturalists will be on hand with displays/information, area birders will be available to take beginning birders on birding walks or accompany you to Market Lake WMA. Learn how to make your backyard a bird paradise!














Directions to the Ducks Unlimited Market Lake Ranch

From Idaho Falls: Travel north on Interstate 15 for approximately 18 miles to Roberts, Idaho. Take the Roberts Exit (Exit 135) east onto E 627 N and drive to North Bassett Road (N 2880 E). Turn north on North Bassett Road. Travel through the town of Roberts for approximately 1.75 miles to the Diamond Road (E 800 N). Turn Left (west) onto the Diamond road and cross over Interstate 15.

The Ducks Unlimited Market Lake Ranch headquarters (formerly Western Wings property) is on the left.

Camas NWR, Mud Lake WMA and Market Lake WMA are easily accessible from this location.
